DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

LOS ANGELES/ACROSS THE ATLANTIC

THU, SEP 21

Begin your exciting journey as you depart Los Angeles on your overnight transatlantic flight to the Holy Land.

ARRIVE TEL AVIV/TIBERIAS

FRI, SEP 22

Arrive in Tel Aviv this afternoon where you will be met and escorted to your waiting motor coach for the transfer to Tiberias and your hotel. Your exciting journey to the Land of the Bible begins. (D)

TIBERIAS – CAPERNAUM/NAZARETH & GALILEE

SAT, SEP 23

Today, cross the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum, center of Jesus' Ministry in the Galilee and Celebrate Mass. Visit the ruins of the Second Century Synagogue. Proceed to Nazareth, the boyhood home of Jesus. Here you will visit the Church of the Annunciation and the winding streets of the old city. (B,D)

TIBERIAS – TABGHA/MAGDALA

SUN, SEP 24

Depart Tiberias today After breakfast, drive to Tabgha, site of the Miracle of the Loaves and Fishes. Continue to Magdala where we will celebrate Mass. (B,D)

TIBERIAS - CANA/BANIAS

MON, SEP 25

Drive to Cana, site of Jesus' first miracle of turning water into wine. We celebrate Mass along with renewal of Wedding vows. We will proceed to Mt. Tabor, traditional site of the Transfiguration. Then on to the Mount of Beatitudes where Jesus preached the famous Sermon on the Mount and chose the Twelve Apostles. Continue to Caesarea Philippi (Banias) the site where Jesus asked Peter "Who do you say that I am?" Return to Tiberias for the night. (B,D)

TIBERIAS/MT. CARMEL/CAESAREA/JERUSALEM

TUE, SEP 26

After breakfast, drive to Mt. Carmel and Celebrate Mass at the Carmelite Monastery. Continue north to Caesarea to view the ruins of the Crusader's fortress and moat and sit in the great Roman amphitheater. Continuing along the coast, you will see the aqueduct that carried water from Mt. Carmel to Caesarea. Proceed to Jerusalem and your hotel. **(B,D)**

JERUSALEM

WED, SEP 27

Drive to the top of the Mount of Olives for a panoramic view of Jerusalem. Visit the Chapel of the Ascension and the Church of Pater Noster. Descend the Mt. of Olives to the Garden of Gethsemane and walk along the ancient olive trees, viewing the Kidron Valley. Visit the Church of All Nations on the Rock of Agony where we will celebrate Mass. Ascend Mount Zion to see the Upper Room, traditional site of the Last Supper. Drive to Bethlehem. Visit the Church of the Nativity. See the Manger where Jesus was born and Shepherd's Field. Time to shop for wood carvings before returning to Jerusalem. **(B,D)**

JERUSALEM

THU, SEP 28

Today enjoy a walking tour of the Old City of Jerusalem. Follow in the footsteps of Jesus as you walk the Via Dolorosa, the traditional way of the Cross to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher., where you will Celebrate Mass. Visit St. Anne's Church and the Pool of Bethesda where Jesus healed the crippled man. Continue to the Temple Area. See the Dome of the Rock, the El Aqsa Mosque and the Wailing Wall. Exit via the Dung Gate to St. Peter's in Gallicantu. View the Valley of Gehenna and the Pool of Siloam. This afternoon, enter Herod's Gate to the Roman Praetorium, beneath the Sisters of Zion Convent, and the Ecce Homo Arch. Leave the Old City through the Damascus Gate. **(B,D)**

JERUSALEM

FRI, SEP 29

This morning drive to Bethany to visit Lazarus' Tomb and the village of Mary and Martha. After Mass, on to



Bethlehem

Biblical Jericho, believed to be the oldest city in the world and the original site of the baptism of Jesus. View Elisha's Spring and the Mount of Temptations. Continue to the Dead Sea, 1288 feet below sea level and enjoy some time to wade in the water, site of ancient Sodom and Gomorrah. Stop at the Caves of Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered and visit the excavations. On the east side of the Dead Sea are the Moab Mountains and Mt. Nebo where Moses viewed the Promised Land. Return to Jerusalem. **(B,D)**

JERUSALEM/TEL AVIV/BOARD FLIGHT HOME

SAT, SEP 30

Late morning checkout from your hotel. The balance of the day is at leisure for shopping and exploring the city on your own or you may join an optional tour of the new city of Jerusalem. This afternoon we will visit Ein Karem and then celebrate Mass at Notre Dame. Following dinner, transfer to the airport for your overnight flight back to the U.S.A. **(B,D)**

ARRIVE LOS ANGELES

SUN, OCT 1

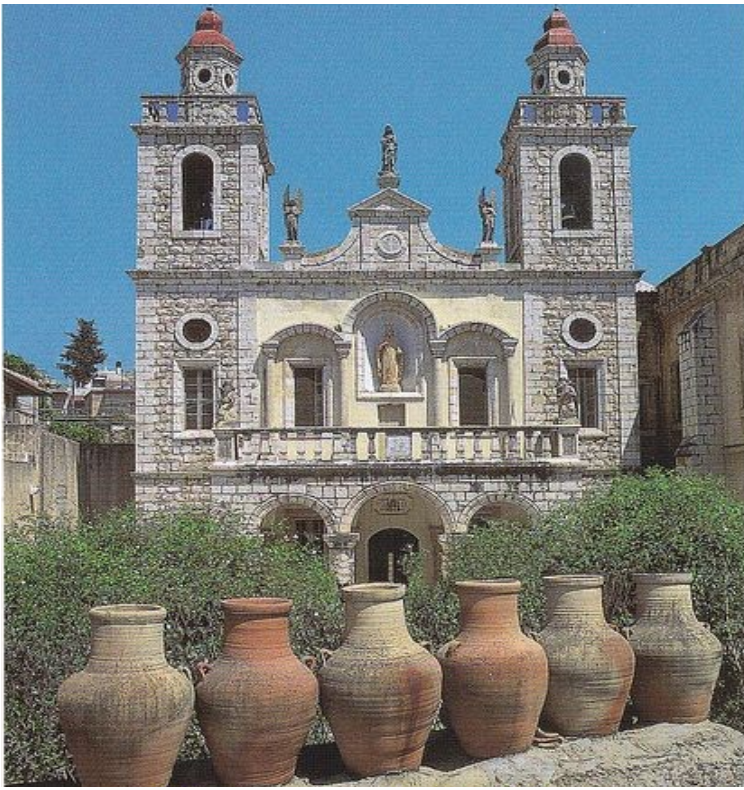
Early morning arrival in the United States where you will connect with your return flight to Los Angeles, arriving around midday.
